On Tuesday, we attended the EBP 'Get Inspired' careers fair at the Guildhall. The children coped amazingly with the walk in the rain: there wasn't a single complaint. Once inside the Guildhall, they were able to visit stalls of many local employers and educational establishments: Hampshire Police, Taylor Wimpy developments, Biscoes law firm, BAE systems, as well as colleges such as Portsmouth and Fareham. Many of the stalls had hands on activities, free food but best of all - pens, pencils and highlighters! Y6 were delighted with the amount of freebies they managed to bring home! As staff, we were extremely proud to hear some exhibitors describe Wimborne children as the most polite children there.

Y4 Times Table Check

Y4 children this week have taken their statutory required Multiplication tables check set by the Government. This is an on-line test where they have to rapidly answer times tables questions up to 12x12. The test is to ensure that children leave lower key stage 2 being able to recall times table facts quickly and accurately, which is what the national curriculum outlines. May I take this opportunity to remind you of the importance of times tables and your role in ensuring regular practice happens at home either through homework tasks, 'Times Tables Rock Stars' or any other way in which your child will help learn these key number facts, which underpin so many mathematical concepts.
