Attendance & Punctuality

At Wimborne we expect a high level of attendance and punctuality. Good attendance at Wimborne is 97% or above. Good attendance and punctuality is rewarded in Celebration Assembly.

'This is Jack. His attendance is 90%.' Is this good? What does it mean? Jack thinks this is pretty good; so do his parents. Are they right? 90% attendance = $\frac{1}{2}$ day missed every week! Over 1 year this means that Jack would have missed 4 whole weeks of lessons.

Being punctual is a key skill we all need in all walks of life. Being late can cause all kinds of issues in daily life: be late for the cinema and you miss the opening scenes to the film, be late for an appointment and you may not be able to get another one, be late for a meeting and you may miss important points made. Being late for school can have huge implications for a child:

- they miss the start of the day when they find out what is planned for the day ahead
- they miss their morning greeting by the class teacher
- they miss the early morning catch up with their friends
- they miss some or all of their reading or phonics lesson, making reading harder in other subjects
- they maybe unsettled and emotional

As we work in partnership to enable your child to have the best learning opportunities, I ask you to support us by not taking your child out of school for family holidays.
